6).. Globalization of Ayurveda - Part I: by Dr. Mala Kapadia

Our history over the last two millenniums is forcing humankind to pause and review where we are going. If the direction appears to be blurred, incorrect, harmful, we need to take a deeper look at where we are going. Technological progress has created a myth of better living, however in reality, our balance, rhythm and harmony have been lost.

The rapid pace and modern technology of today is exerting extreme pressure on humanity and contributes to major malfunctions in the body and psyche. Stress is giving rise to diseases like Chronic Fatigue Syndrome - CFS., and studies have found that up to 80% of chronically fatigued people score high in depression and anxiety. In America alone, between 100,000 and 250,000 adults suffer from CFS. (And these figures are pre-WTC 9/11 attack). Another symptom of the stress is over

indulgence in food or other physical pleasures and ninety-seven million Americans, nearly 55% of the U.S. adult population, are overweight, with 22.5% being obese, according to the National Institute of Health. The numbers are mind boggling, and this is catching up globally like an epidemic. The fertility rates in developed countries are deteriorating due to stress as well.

Waking up to ancient wisdom

The world is now looking for solutions from areas it had earlier negated. The allopathic medicines have not proved to be healing holistically, and Chinese herbal, Tibetan medicines and Ayurveda are sciences that are being revived with great enthusiasm. The world is rapidly becoming smaller, becoming a global village, thanks to the Information Age, and Ayurveda, one of the oldest sciences of well-being, is being revived at global level. Caution, therefore, needs to be taken. Failure of mainstream medicine has given way to alternate and complementary healing arts and sciences. Research suggests that as much as 50% of the world's population is leaning towards this trend. (USA 40%, UK 40% And Australia 60%, the rest of the world is in between these numbers) Certainly, the best opportunity for India to take its rightful place as the birthplace of this Vedic science.

Ayurveda as it is today: Fragmented use of Ayurveda

One can't deny the fact the Ayurveda is derived from Atharva Veda and has Vedic origin. We have accepted or denied the science without verifying the research. On the other hand, the Western world is adapting research and documentation of information through experiments from the ancient wisdom of Ayurvedic texts. This also gives rise to patent issues, something that we Indians as a culture do not believe in. For us, knowledge is for well being of mankind and not for commercial exploitation. This is resulting in two different problem areas. One, the amount spent on fighting legal battles to stop the patenting of Turmeric (Haridra or Haldee), Neem and Basmati rice is mind-boggling. If only we had wisely utilized our knowledge in the same way, researching, and coming up with modernizing Ayurveda. Two, there are Vaidyas (physicians of Ayurveda) with lots of knowledge in the application of Ayurveda but they are not passing it on, as they view their knowledge as a Divine gift that can't be commercialized. Their expertise is dying with them and we end up having to reinvent the wheel.

We now have two classes of people • those who practice Ayurveda and are not ready to examine why research and documentation is essential. On the other hand we have mainstream allopathic doctors and followers who are denying the wisdom of this science without verifying its value. There is a small section of practitioners and pharmacists who are carrying out research and coming up with a variety of applications.

The world is turning to Holistic Healing

The majority of Ayurveda practitioners are today no different than their allopathic fraternity. They diagnose and give medicines or treatments. Ayurveda's basic principles and the 'whole' science are not practiced today. Ayurveda was the first science of healing that established the mind/body connection and energy principles that Quantum physics and PNI are talking about today. The

Western world is fast recognizing this connection and coming up with more holistic application of our science.

This is where the education and awareness of holistic Ayurveda comes into the picture. Mental health is one of the biggest challenges in this millennium. The 'Well Being' revolution is demanding holistic sciences that can work on mind/body/spirit. Ayurveda has valuable insights not only in terms of drugs and treatment, but also in psychotherapy, through Mantra, gems, meditation and Yajna. Ayurveda, as it is taught today, does not provide a total education, due to the belief that the above were thought to be non-scientific. In fact they work on energy principles. The Energy principles of Sattva, Rajas and Tamas need to be re-evaluated in terms of quantum physics and healing sciences. Prana or life force energy is the basis of life and well-being. The imbalances of energies in today's world are also affecting the mental energies.
